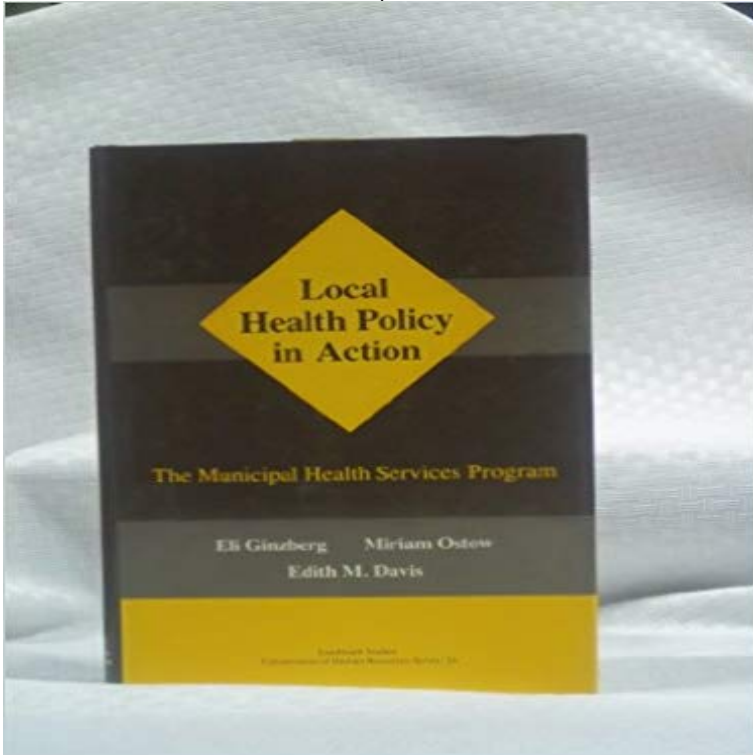


# Local Health Policy in Action
