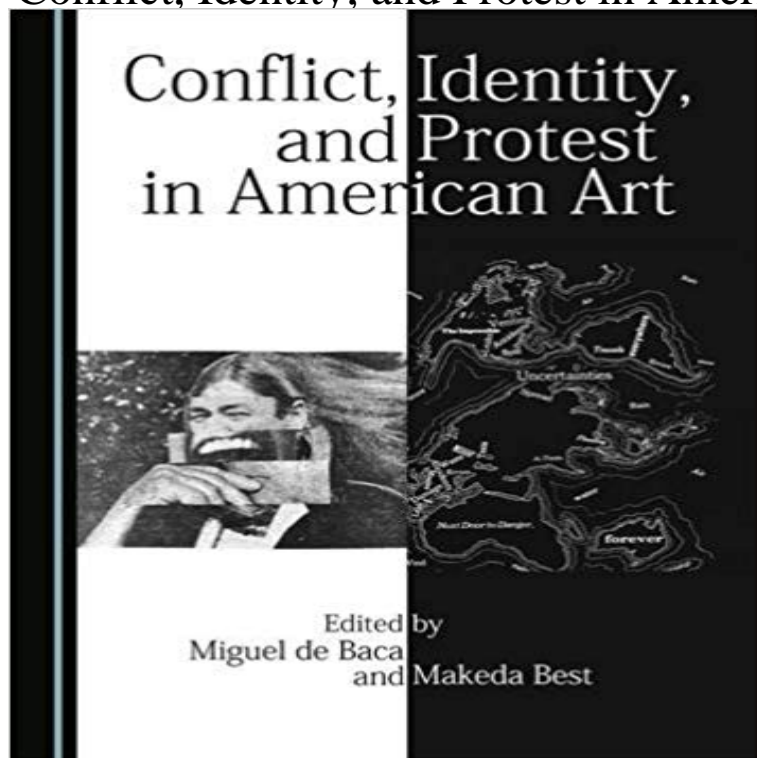


Conflict, Identity, and Protest in American Art
