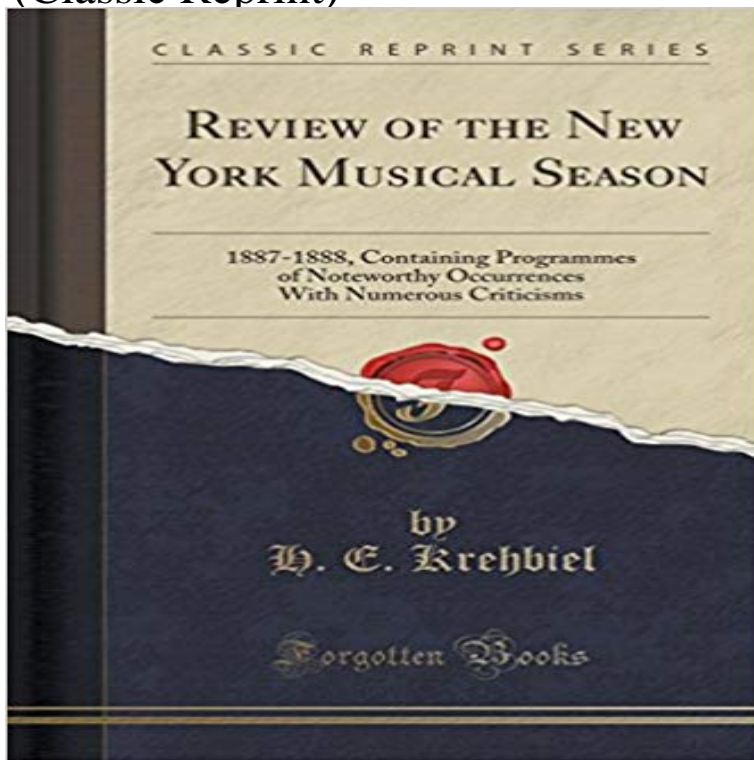

In determining what to include in it I have tried to be guided entirely by the question of artistic significance and value. The number of musical entertainments omitted is small; as a rule, they were pupils and benefit concerts. When performances of novelties are credited to the concerts of the New York Philharmonic Society, Brooklyn Philharmonic Society, Symphony Society, or Mr. Thomas (except the Popular Matinees), it should be borne in mind that the compositions were, in reality, first heard at the public rehearsals for these concerts. In the first three cases these rehearsals look place on the afternoon of the preceding day; in the last case, on the preceding Thursday afternoon.
