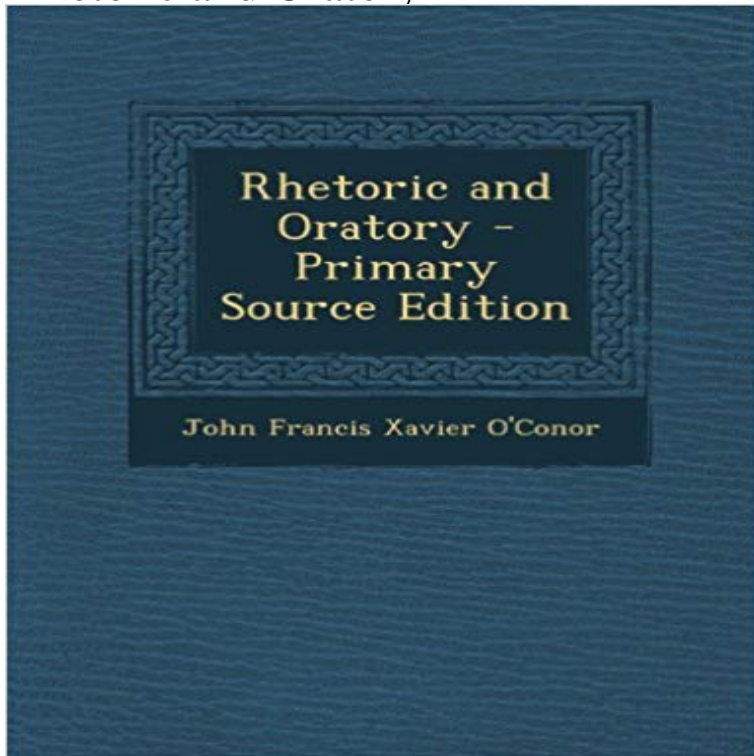


Rhetoric and Oratory
