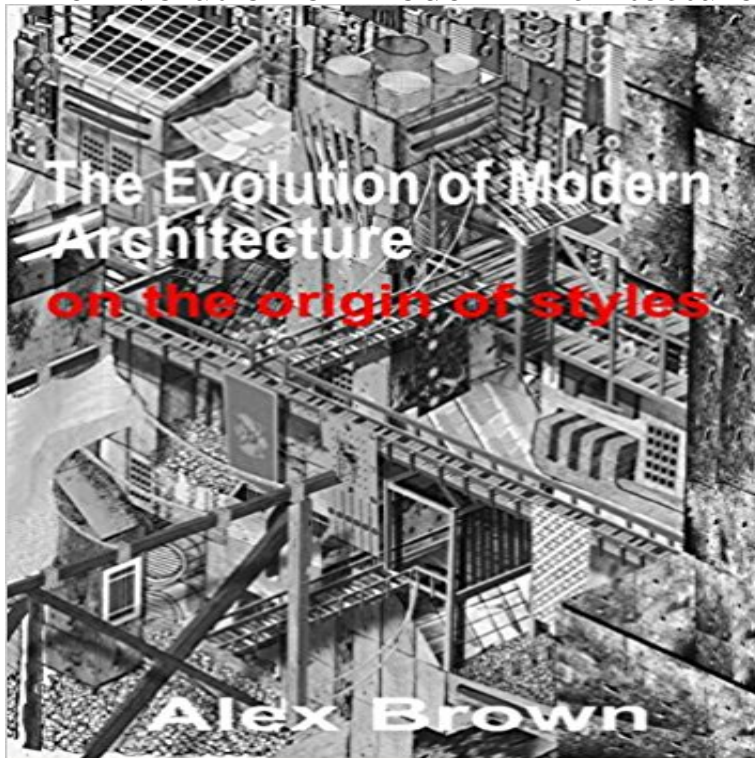


The Evolution of Modern Architecture: On the Origin of Styles



History is simply a catalogue of facts which explain nothing. The rise and fall of architectures demands an explanation which involves the reality of many architects interacting with one another to produce coherent and regulated entities called styles which periodize history. Using evolutionary and complexity theory it is possible to understand the formation of architectures. While buildings are material objects, architecture is the information that informs and characterizes those objects. This information and the experience of many architects produce styles which encapsulate the experience of those many architects working in the midst of different environmental conditions and the different building types that they require. Communication, exchange and adaptation between architects is the fundamental activity in the formation of styles and of architectures. This continuous process set in the midst of different environmental conditions produces different end results. This book explains how the interaction of so many architects with their own unique projects could produce apparently unified styles. Evolutionary theory explains how the attempt to adapt form to unique function in individual cases when spread over so many projects can only result in the formation of a consensus, a style which is a snapshot of architecture at a given point in time. Complexity theory looks at how a mass of agents each focussed on their own issues can in certain circumstances create a dominant stylistic consensus. The book addresses the evolution of Modern Architecture from the diversity of the 19th century not as a deliberate choice on the part of the avant garde but as the inevitable but unforeseen result of many individual architectural choices. Finally, the book examines the systemic changes in architecture in the post war world through the International style to the disintegration of the Modern in the Postmodern world.

None of these changes were conscious inventions on the part of the avant garde but rather the cumulative result of many architects work. Three stages are defined in this work: Emergence, Development and Involution which describe the different stages of an architecture as it moves through its history towards the point where a new architecture emerges.
